



TOWN AND COUNTRY LAWYER CHARGED WITH STEALING FROM COURT FILE:

If it is not bad enough to be a defendant in an adult stalking case and having a protection order issued against you but then get charged with stealing from the court file pretty well makes you out to be chump of the month.

That is exactly what has happened to Scott Ehlermann, who lives at 12623 Laurel Lake Court in Town and Country's Ward 2, an area chocked full of white collar criminals.

Ehlermann was divorced in April of 2004 from Karen Ellermann. They had three children and Scott Ehlermann was ordered to pay \$990 monthly in child support.

On 11/30/04 Scott Ehlermann filed to amend the divorce agreement. At one point in this matter Karen Ehlermann lost all control and hired Million Dollar John Diehl as her lawyer. She apparently came to her senses and later hired another lawyer. This motion filed by Scott Ehlermann was later dismissed by both parties.

On November 16, 2012 Scott Ehlermann again filed a motion to amend the divorce decree.

The case continues on and a deposition is scheduled in October, almost 10 years after the divorce was granted.

(As a side note according to the court file Ehlermann hired Kevin Burgdorf on November 21, 2012 as a special process server. Kevin and I were in the same class at the St. Louis Police Academy back in 1974. Just before reaching his retirement eligibility with the St. Louis Police Department Kevin was fired after he was caught shoplifting at a K-Mart in St. Louis.)

Marie Dianna Lipowicz of Ballwin filed a paternity suit against Ehlermann on May 31, 2011. There were motions back and forth with judgments ordered against Lipowicz and Ehlermann. Lipowicz is a lawyer having passed the bar in 2010.

On December 29, 2011 a court order was issued ordering Ehlermann not to stalk, contact, speak to the petitioner, who is not named in the court orders. However one court ruling mentions a specific case by number and it is the paternity case filed by Lipowicz against Ehlermann. This case like most cases filed against Ehlermann has gone on-and-on and is still active.

On January 12, 2012 a full order of protection was issued against Ehlermann by Judge John Borbonus. Ehlermann appealed the ruling six days later. On May 24, 2012 the case was assigned to Judge Michael Burton.

It was clear that the unnamed petitioner was Lipowicz because on February 5, 2014 Judge Burton ordered Ehlermann to stop filing BAR complaints against the petitioner with the Missouri Supreme Court. If it turns out that GOD is a woman, Ehlermann may be in big trouble when he appears in his final case. Here is the criminal complaint against him that is likely to result in a Grand Jury Indictment.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows: Defendant, who is a licensed attorney in the State of Missouri, was the respondent in an adult abuse/order of protection case (cause No. 11SL-PN05299) filed with the Circuit Court of St. Louis County. He presented himself at the Adult Abuse office, represented to a clerk that he was an attorney on that case, and asked to review the file. Two witnesses who were sitting in the Adult Abuse waiting room saw defendant remove a piece of paper from the file before handing the file back to the clerk. One of the witnesses notified the clerk, but defendant left the office, denying that he had taken anything from the file. Defendant was arrested several days later but refused to make a statement. The special prosecuting attorney for the petitioner on the case confirmed that a document was missing from the file; it was a portion of an exhibit relating to an amendment of an order of protection issued against defendant.

SPEEDING CASE PENDING: Ehlermann also has a speeding case filed by the Town and Country Police for doing 94 mph in a 60 mph zone. That was filed on 12/03/13. He demanded a jury and it was set on a County docket for 6/19/14. On 6/20 the case had disappeared from the docket. We will be checking to see if it goes back to T&C Court.

ANOTHER ARREST AND ANOTHER NEW SUSPECT IN THORNHILL BURGLARY AND BEATING CASE: The case of the burglary, beating and car theft at 12951 Thornhill Drive on May 9 grows wider.



Convicted felon Thomas Ruzicka was renting the home that was also for sale being marketed as a "tear-down." He was badly beaten with a bar stool leaving him unconscious, with a swollen and bleeding brain. He is currently in rehab.



Daniel Denzel Martin was quickly charged with Assault First Degree, Armed Criminal Action, First Degree Burglary, Stealing Over \$500 and Auto Theft after an investigation by the Major Case Squad. He is being held in the County Jail on a \$150,000 bond.

On Wednesday June 11, 2014 Town and Country detectives arrested a 16-year-old juvenile who admitted involvement with the crime. It has not yet been determined if the juvenile will be charged as an adult or handled by the Family Services Juvenile Court.

Town and Country Police detectives are searching for two more adult suspects connected with this case.

To make this case even more interesting, Daniel Denzel Martin's two brothers were arrested on June 9 in an undercover drug buy that turned into a shoot out with County undercover officers on the front porch of the Martin brothers' home in Bel Ridge.

Joshua pulled a gun when the narcotics detectives attempted to arrest the brothers after buying marijuana. He was promptly shot twice in the arm by the police. He joins younger brother Daniel in the County Jail being held on \$150,000 bond for first Degree Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer. Christopher makes it a trio of jailed brothers as he is being held on an \$80,000 bond for Distributing Narcotics.



DEER VEHICLE ACCIDENTS DOWN 44% THIS YEAR OVER

2013! There were only four motor vehicle-deer collisions for the month of May in Town and Country. In 2013 the number of deer-vehicle accidents through May was 32. So far this year there is a 44% drop with only 18 reported accidents.

The accidents in May were on Mason Road at Kings Glen, SB 270 at Clayton Road, NB 270 at I-64 and WB I-64 at Mason Road.

EX-CONVICT DRUG DEALER'S HOUSE ONCE AGAIN DECLARED A WEED AND HIGH GRASS NUISANCE:

The first official hearing on September 13 after giving up his title of "Acting City Administrator" for the full time title for Gary Hoelzer was to declare the property at 1761 Topping Road a nuisance due to high grass and weeds. The city paid \$600 to have a private company harvest the weeds and placed a lien on the property. The owner, Brian Marchant-Calsyn, a former convicted drug dealer having spent time in the Lewisburg Federal Prison paid off the lien in December of 2013.

Marchant-Calsyn had moved from the house in April of 2012 and it went on the market. However after a year the "for sale" sign disappeared. The front 2-acre parcel of his property was foreclosed on by the bank and purchased by a developer and is now for sale.

On Tuesday June 17 at 10:05am Hoelzer's second Nuisance High Grass and Weed hearing took place. It was the same property. For a second time Marchant-Calsyn did not show up. The hearing was over in one minute and Hoelzer ordered City Planner and Enforcement Officer Melanie Rippetoe to proceed with hiring a contractor to cut the grass and weeds.

I demand a written public apology.



BILLINGS IS A PERFECT EXAMPLE OF THE PROBLEM: Billings sits in judgment of drunk drivers and others as municipal judge in Des Peres, but his law firm advertises on its website that they specialize in DWI defense. Even if it is son defending the drunks Billings and his firm still reaps profits when clients get sweet deals. The same goes for Tim Englemeyer, the Chesterfield prosecutor and Creve Coeur judge and Chesterfield Judge Rick Brunk , who with one hand are expected to look out for the health, safety and welfare of the public at large, but in their private practice represent drunk drivers and are looking for sweetheart deals.

You cannot expect these guys to be tough on drunks and thieves one night, when the next day they are trying to get clients charged with similar offenses off with no record.

CHESTERFIELD COP SECRETLY RECORDING MEN PEEING AT GAS STATION NOW EX-COP:



Chesterfield Police Officer David Cerna took pen to paper and wrote out a letter of resignation as police were searching his house in Wentzville looking for evidence of a videos secretly recorded of men urinating in a Chesterfield Gas Station restroom. The investigation also led to evidence that Cerna was creating videos of men lured to his house by internet ads for sex with women. When they arrived they were instructed to use a "glory hole" in a door while Cerna recorded himself performing oral sex. The recordings were later posted on the internet.

The entire case broke thanks to a tip to KTVI's Chris Hayes who was able to determine the Clarkson Road Mobil on the Run restroom video was being used on a website called "Restroom Recon."

Officers executed a search warrant at the six-year veteran police officer's house and at that time according to Chief Ray Johnson, Cerna wrote out a resignation letter which was immediately accepted in lieu of termination.

The police were able to indentify at least eight people video recorded using the restroom who images were later posted on a website called "Restroom Recon." KTVI's Chris Hayes interviewed one of the men.

Caught on that video included but is not limited to A.L., C.S., M.A., N.W., S.H., C.T., T.J., and T.L, all of whom have been identified and stated it was without their knowledge and consent. The video captures all of the above victims, exposing their penises to use the facilities. Defendant has admitted participation in the offense.



FIRE DISTRICT CHAIRMAN SUDDENLY RESIGNS...RECENT ARREST FOR PROMOTING PROSTITUTION FOUND: Richard Rognan who was just finished two years of his third six year term in April , abruptly resigned as the Chairman of the West County EMS & Fire Protection District.



Rogan who works as a local CPA and provides services to other union controlled fire districts is best known to many Town and Country residents as the guy who after signing a 5-year \$18 million contract to provide fire and EMS services to Town Country from January 01, 2006 to December 31, 2010 attempted to negate the contract by annexing Town and Country into the Fire District. The Fire District property tax at the time was 82-cents on \$100 assessed valuation. Town and Country residents were paying no property taxes for city and fire services and the annexation would have raised residents' taxes between \$500 and \$2,000 annually. The annexation election was cancelled due to strong opposition in Town and Country.

Also on 01/26/06 Rognan was cited for speeding 71 mph in a 45 mph zone in Manchester. He demanded a jury trial to have the case sent to the Circuit Court and then pled guilty to a reduced charge of "Illegal Parking" and was fined \$262.

We mention this traffic charge because of another recent charge that Rognan was facing that we are trying to find out the final disposition.

After reading the letter of resignation I asked the fire district attorney Chuck Billings if there are been any subpoenas that have been served on the district. Chuck laughed and said absolutely not and Rognan just had too much going on with his business and was worried working with other fire districts might appear to be a conflict.

I wasn't buying this and dug a little deeper.

THE ARREST...LOOKING FOR SEX FROM A 19-YEAR-OLD UMSL COED: It turns out that 54-year-old Richard Rognan was arrested on August 8, 2013 on a charge of Soliciting Prostitution from a "teenager" that turned out to be a police decoy in the tiny town of Velda City located along Lucas and Hunt Road just north of Hillsdale and Wellston.

The 10-officer Velda City Police Department on occasion will bait a trap to try and catch people using the internet to look for love.

In this case they placed an ad on Craig's List claiming to be a 19-year female college student at UMSL looking "to hang out tonite be rl and have a pic and we can see what's up."

The police report indicates within 20 minutes there were 10-to-20 responses to the ad.

One response which turned out to be from Richard Rognan, the Chairman of the West county EMS & Fire Protection District under the name "Hot Spoil."

Here is what Rognan wrote according to police:

"Hello - I like what I see - I am available to hang out tonight and spoil you \$\$\$\$. I am in great shape and good looking, generous and I do like to spoil U. can I spoil you tonight?"

Police decoy: "wat did u have in mind"

Rognan: "BJ and fuck...can I spoil you tonight?"

Police Decoy: "How much for all that?"

Rognan: "150"

Decoy: "dam that much? U have a pic?"

How do we know that these messages are from Rognan...because he sent the police decoy his photo! This is a guy who was running a multi-million dollar government agency that was supposed to be protecting the public, including 19-year-old teenage college coeds.

Rognan even told the teenager (cops) he'd be driving a Lincoln. Guess what?...they were waiting for him when he pulled up in his 2011 white Lincoln Navigator.

When the cops contacted Rognan after he pulled into the apartments parking lot where he was told to go at 2800 Glen Parkway he flashed his gold West County EMS & FPD Director badge.

At first he claimed he was on fire district business to meet someone who works for the fire district. He then admitted he was meeting a UMSL student for "some fun."

He was arrested and police found in his right front pocket a Trojan Condom and \$150 in cash. He was charged under a City Ordinance Violation of Patronizing Prostitution and released on a \$1,000 bond.

MY MONRING AT VELDA CITY MUNICIPAL COURT: I was able to get a copy of the police report with little trouble and \$15.50 in cash. The police chief was aware this was an open record, meaning there was an open disposition after a guilty plea (probably to a lesser charge). However getting anything information out of the Velda City Court was a horse of another color.

Ironically the city attorney for all the rich folks in Town and Country is also city attorney for Velda City, Steve Garrett. The email I sent to Mr. Garrett pretty well describes my morning at the Velda City Municipal court inside the city hall which was once a 7-11.

On Thursday June 19 at 11am I went to the Velda City, City Hall to check the disposition of a municipal court case filed August 8, 2013 by the Velda City Police against one Richard Rognan. (cit 120951860). A woman who I believed to be an assistant court clerk said I had to fill out a written request.

I always thought court records were open to the public and requiring (no) Sunshine Law forms. However, I wrote out a request.

Another woman, who I took to be the court clerk told me she was too busy to look up the disposition and she would get back to me. I told her I had the latest John Grisham novel in the car and I would just read it in the lobby until she had time to give me the disposition.

30 minutes into my novel, I was called into the offices and handed a phone and spoke with a member of your law firm who is also the prosecutor in Velda City, your law firms' Pat Chassaing. Mr. Chassaing said you were out of town and would have to be contacted before a public court record of disposition could be revealed.

I told him that I thought court records in Missouri were supposed to be public records and available to the public.

He replied that Velda City had 72 hours under the Sunshine Law.

I replied that I went there to find an open public court disposition, but was forced by staff to make a written request and that court records should not require a Sunshine request.

He replied nothing would happen until you advised.

I find this unusual, since one of your other fiefdoms, Town and Country, works very simply. I ask the court clerk for a disposition and she provides it to me.

I'm curious do these two cities work under different laws concerning court records?

Please provide the court disposition of citation 120951860 as soon as possible.

NARRATIVE

Sir,

On 08/08/2013, the Velda City Apprehension Team (VCAT) was conducting a covert computer investigation involving solicitation of prostitution; where the decoy was playing the role of a prostitute.

Utilizing the undercover preset email address tonyayobaby@gmail.com, I placed an ad onto Craigslist.org website under (w4m) meaning women

for men. This website is used for person(s) to place classified ads for casual encounters and or general meet and greets.

The VCAT decoy ad read as follows:

The ad title reads:

"Student lookin to chill 420 friendly" - w4m - 19 (Ums1)"

The body of the ad reads:

"lookin to hang out tonite be rl and have a pic and we can talk and see whats up".

Under Craigslist.org post ID number# 3989905495 (See attached evidence sheet for printout of the craigslist.com decoy ad).

It should be noted, that the ad placed by the decoy was meant to be a broad ad, to let the suspect(s) determine where their mind set was.

To respond to the ad, person(s) click on the link on the page (advertisement), at which time they can then send a return email to the original person who posted the ad, which would go into our undercover email tonyyobaby@gmail.com.

Approximately 15-20 minutes after our decoy ad was posted on the Craigslist website, we had received approximately 10-20 email responses from numerous subjects in reference to our ad. After mentioning to users that they would have to pay for sexual acts, most of them stopped emailing the decoy.

One subject emailed the decoy using email address: 6e1424270aad37448942f92d82e4e635@reply.craigslist.org) with a name attached to the email address referring to the subject as "hot spoil".

On 08/08/2013, "hot spoil" initiated contact with the decoy.

It should be noted the following is a synopsis of the email transactions between the suspect known as "hot spoil" and the decoy:

"Hot Spoil" emailed, "Hello - I like what I see - I am available to hang out tonight and spoil you \$\$\$\$. I am in great shape and good looking, generous and I do like to spoil - can I spoil you tonight?"

Decoy emailed, "wat did u have in mind"

Hot Spoil emailed, "BJ and fuck... can I spoil you tonight?"

Decoy emailed, "how much for all that?"

Hot Spoil emailed, "150"

Decoy emailed, "dam that much? U have a pic?"

Hot Spoil emailed, "here you go - how about an address?" (This message included a full facial picture of a white male)

Decoy emailed, "2800 glen parkway itz a apartment tho so just park and honk or sumethin an dont be laughin at how messy my place is"

Hot Spoil emailed, "I am on my way now - I will park and honk - not a problem..."

Decoy emailed, "k wat u drivin so I dun be walkin up on some stranga lol"

Hot Spoil emailed, "Lincoln - on my way - I have no way to get emails - OK"

That ended the most pertinent email transactions between the decoy and the suspect "Hot Spoil" (See attached evidence for email transactions).

Prior to the suspect (Hot Spoil) arrival to the preset take down location of 2800 Glen Parkway (which is within the City of Velda City venue). Officer Ketz DSN 350 and I responded to said location prior to the suspect's arrival. We set up surveillance out of sight, and waited inside our marked patrol cars for the suspect to arrive.

At approximately 22:05 hours, I observed a white Lincoln Navigator turn into the parking lot of 2800 Glen Parkway. I advised Officer Ketz by radio that I believe this was the suspect's vehicle.

I observed the vehicle travel east down Glen Parkway, where it stopped and honked its horn once, this was part of the instructions given to "Hot Spoil" from the decoy. The vehicle then stopped for approximately one minute before continuing further down Glen Parkway. The Navigator then turned west on Myron Ave, and started traveling towards Lucas Hunt at what I believed to be a very slow rate of speed. I activated my emergency lights and siren, stopping the vehicle at 2560 Lucas Hunt Rd.

The vehicle was identified as a:

White 2011 Lincoln Navigator
Plate: DF3-D3S EX: 2014

I exited my patrol car and made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle who was later identified as:

Rognan, Richard
W/M DOB: 05/26/1959

I advised Rognan I was conducting a suspicious vehicle stop and asked to see his operator's license and proof of financial responsibility; he was able to produce both documents. Rognan also handed me a gold color badge that was stamped with "Director West County EMS and Fire".

I asked Rognan to exit the vehicle and join me and Officer Ketz in front of my fully marked patrol vehicle. Once there I asked Rognan what brought him to the area from his current address in Ballwin. Rognan stated he was on his way to Pennsylvania Ave to meet up with a friend who works at the fire district. When asked why he turned down Glen Parkway, Rognan became very nervous (hands shaking, unable to make eye contact). Rognan lowered his head and said "Ok fine, I'm actually here to meet a UMSL student for some fun".

After making that statement, Rognan was advised he was being placed under arrest for patronizing prostitution. Rognan was handcuffed to the rear (checked for fit and double locked) and led towards the rear of my marked patrol vehicle. During an initial search of Rognan I was able to locate the following in his right front pocket:

1. Trojan Condom
2. (1) 100.00 dollar bill U.S currency
3. (2) 20.00 dollar bills U.S currency
4. (1) 10.00 dollar bill U.S currency

The currency located in Rognan's front right pocket matched the amount agreed upon between the decoy and "Hot Spoil" for sexual favors. The money and condoms were seized and photographed by this officer.

During an inventory of Rognan's vehicle, the built in dash GPS system was observed to the have the address of 2800 Glen Parkway displayed. This was also the address agreed upon by the decoy and "Hot Spoil" to meet. The GPS unit was photographed by this officer.

All evidence was seized by this officer and later properly packaged and entered into evidence.

The vehicle was towed from scene by A 2 B towing to the address of 6041 N. Lindbergh per department policy. It was entered in as towed under reference #V23082772.

Rognan was transported to the Velda City Police Department. Once at the station the suspect was escorted into the booking room. The subject was first read and explained his constitutional rights per Miranda. Rognan stated he did not wish to speak or make a statement without his attorney present (See attached evidence sheet).

The subject was booked and issued the following citation:

1. Patronizing Prostitution CIT: 120951860

Rognan was given a court date of 10/09/2013 at 09:00 hours to be held at the Velda City Municipal court building.

Rognan was issued a \$1,000 dollar bond for his charges, which was later posted under receipt # 17903

COMMENT ON GETTING COURT RECORDS AND THE FAIRNESS OF SEX


STINGS: : Someone in the know has told me the reason the Velda City Court is stalling in providing disposition information is because they reduced the charge to "Littering." I have also been told by someone who has provided very accurate information to me in the past that Richard Rognan was represented by a lawyer who has already been mentioned in this newsletter or possibly the lawyer's son...which some would feel is a possible conflict of interest.

It feels odd that the residents of a majority African-American populated city like Velda City have to put up with white elected officials from West County coming to their community to participate in prostitution. Hiding the court records and/or reducing the charge to "littering" or "illegal parking" sends the wrong message. I'm sure that charge would not be reduced if someone from Velda City came to West County wanting to participate in teenage prostitution.

Some might claim that no one speeds on Lucas and Hunt anymore since it is such a well known speed trap and reverse prostitution stings are a good way to raise money. However, being a cop for 30 years I know full well that apartments with lower rents in towns like Velda City are often where prostitutes will work from. I have to think there has been some prostitution problems before causing the cops to be pro active.

Of course for police reverse stings to be fully effective you have to publicize them including naming those who are arrested. The Velda City police chief is following the Missouri Open Records Law...however for the stings to really work there needs to be press releases or it might look like a revenue raising activity.

Also this does not mean the white attorneys from West County representing the Velda City should be reducing these offenses, especially when the defendants are from West County and represented by lawyers from West County?



Euro Motorcars says goodbye to Rolls-Royce, hello to Volvo

Bethesda dealership trading in luxury for family friendly

Bethesda hovers near the top of lists of the nation's [highest-earning communities](#), but its residents tend to be conservative in their choice of cars, one dealer said.

Euro Motorcars, which operates several auto dealerships in the area, shuttered its Rolls-Royce and Bentley showroom in downtown Bethesda last September and plans to reopen it this summer with Volvos.

Gil Hofheimer, general manager of the new Volvo store, said the high-end Rolls and Bentley cars have become socially questionable in the Washington area.

“It became a car that people were reluctant to be seen in because of the statement that it made,” he said. “It was a little too opulent for the area.”

On the other hand, in areas such as Miami, Las Vegas and Los Angeles, which are “a little bit more glitzy,” Hofheimer said, those models sell very well. Most Rolls-Royce models sell for \$250,000 and up.

Not so in Washington.

“In a region where people are more concerned with the ecology, the environment [and] political statements, the car made the wrong statement, shall we say,” he said. Many models get about 20 miles per gallon on the highway and about 12 in city driving, according to the Environmental Protection Agency.

The nearest Rolls-Royce dealership is now in Sterling, Va. Bentley Tysons in Vienna, Va., bought out Euro Motorcars’ Bentley business, and Simone Durbin, director of business development, said the company sells an average of five a month.

“Bentleys are moving actually very well, considering the price tag,” Durbin said. “‘Economically friendly’ is simply not in our clients’ vocabulary.”

Volvo has a reputation for being a safe family vehicle, Hofheimer said. Next year’s Volvos also will have some features in common with the Mercedes-Benz, which Euro Motorcars already sells from its main downtown showroom on Arlington Road. The features include Apple CarPlay, which displays iPhone apps on a screen in the car, and the capability to receive information about road hazards via satellite.

“Volvo has always had a safety heritage, as does Mercedes-Benz, and we feel that more closely aligns with our mission,” Hofheimer said.

He said a tremendous number of apartments are being built in the three blocks around the new dealership — which is at the more southern corner of Wisconsin and Woodmont avenues — and in Bethesda as a whole, and Volvos are popular.

“We are right in the middle of ‘Volvo land,’ as the manufacturer calls it,” Hofheimer said. “There are probably more Volvos registered in Bethesda-Chevy Chase than there are in any community in the Washington-metro area.”

Euro Motorcars bought the old Martens Volvo in Washington and is operating out of its showroom until moving to Bethesda. Hofheimer said he expects the new Volvo showroom to open Aug. 1.
